

Village Landfills & Transfer Stations

Council provides and maintains 5 village landfills (Bribbaree, Tubbul, Milvale, Bendick Murrell & Koorawatha) and 2 transfer stations (Monteagle and Murrungo).

Use of these facilities is available for residents who pay the non urban DWM charge on their rates and access is via a registered key system maintained by Council.

Keys are available to eligible residents upon payment of a fully refundable deposit.

Village Landfill's and Transfer Stations are a resource to the residents and are intended to allow residents to dispose of rubbish at a local facility.

It is important that residents dispose of waste responsibly so that these facilities can remain operational.

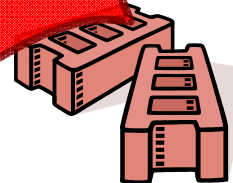
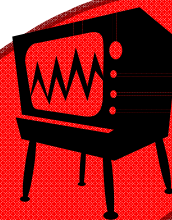
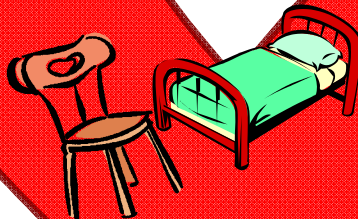
These facilities are only for domestic household waste - all other waste must be delivered and disposed of at the relevant facility in Young.

REMEMBER...

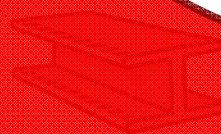
- Only domestic waste is accepted at Landfill & Transfer Stations

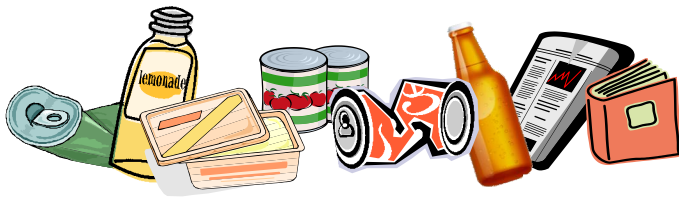

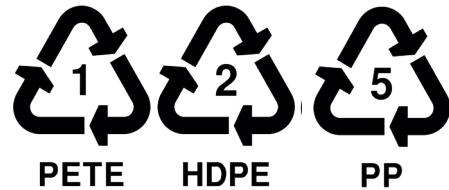
