## IF IT DOESN'T GROW IT DOESN'T GO

### HANDY HINTS

Mow your lawn when it's dry. Don't overpack your bin.

Garden waste must be inside the green waste bin with the lid fully closed. Any waste left on top of, or beside, the bin will not be collected. . Bins that are overfilled or weigh more than **30** kilograms will not be collected.

### WHEN IS GREEN WASTE COLLECTED

Council collects your green waste bin every 2 weeks. The day of your green waste collection depends on where you live, Collection days are indicated on the collection maps.
