# **AMUSEMENT DEVICES POLICY**

**NO 30**

**DATE ADOPTED: 18/09/13**

- 1.1 A fee per device may be charged, and for any device operated by private enterprise for any other venue or function of a public nature.
- 2.1 The fee be payable at the time of inspection.
- 3.1 The proprietor or operator of each device shall keep at the device the current licence, WorkCover registration, log books and the certificate of currency for the public liability insurance or a copy thereof, so that the full inspection may be made without delay.
- 4.1 The Show Secretary or event organiser, shall, after liaison with the Showmen's Guild or the proprietors involved, notify Council of the earliest possible time and day for inspection.
- 5.1 A device shall not be allowed to operate without satisfying the requirements of 2 and 3 above and also the applicable legislation and standards with regard to the erection and operation of such devices.
- 6.1 No inspection charge can be made for devices operated by service organisations, or those exempted under explicit advice from the Showman's Guild (ie Junior rides).
