**ROADS – BANNERS OVER
BOOROWA STREET
POLICY**

NO 18

DATE ADOPTED: 21/8/13

1. As a matter of Policy the use of the banner air space over Boorowa Street be reserved for public events of a tourism, recreation and social welfare nature;
2. Social welfare issues are issues which are designed to raise the awareness of the community to potential problems within the community that are supported at a State level;
3. In the event that a request to erect a banner for a social welfare issue clashes with a request to erect a banner for a tourism or recreation event, the request for the tourism or recreation event shall take priority.
4. The cost of erecting the banner should include traffic control and labour costs and shall be in accordance with Council's annual fees and charges.
