

HERBICIDE USE NOTIFICATION

Commencing 13th July, 2012, until 4th October, 2012 Council will be utilising Round Up, Brush Off, Pulse, Grazon on:

- all sealed roads in Young Shire
- Various Parks, Reserves and Oval – both Rural & Urban
- Chemical spray exotic vegetation in the road reserve (fenceline to fenceline): Murringo Road from Showground to Commons Road; Waterview Road;
- Chemical spray roadside native suckers/Chemical spray exotic vegetation in road reserve up to 10m from edge of seal Scenic Road (sealed section only)
- Chemical spray exotic vegetation in road reserve/Chemical spray roadside suckers: Hardy's Road and Purchase Street
- chemical spray suckers in creek area behind guard rail on 10 Mile Creek on Murringo Road.

In accordance with Council's Herbicide Use Notification Plan, signs will be provided on the vehicle applying the pesticide and signs will remain on-site to inform the public for 24 hours after spraying.

APPLICATION TO DISCHARGE LIQUID TRADE WASTE INTO COUNCILS SEWER

Young Shire Council is currently in the process of implementing its new Liquid Trade Waste policy. Recently Council sent a large number of information packs to local businesses that may require approval for liquid trade waste discharges. Council requests that businesses complete and return to Council before the 1st September 2012.

Sound regulation of sewerage and liquid trade waste is a key component of the NSW Government's Best-Practice Management of Water Supply and Sewerage Guidelines, 2007. All Councils were expected to comply with the requirements of the Best-Practice Management Guidelines by June 2009. Council, together with the community is working towards meeting these objectives.

Council has a responsibility under section 68 of the Local Government Act, 1993 to ensure that any person wishing to discharge liquid trade waste to a council's sewerage system obtain approval from Council. Council would like to work with businesses to ensure that all dischargers are registered with Council and have received appropriate approvals.

Any business discharging into Council's sewer that has not received a Liquid Trade Waste application and information pack or is unsure if their business activities produce a liquid trade waste should contact Council.

Examples of businesses that can produce liquid trade waste are: Food Shop, Café, Restaurants, Funeral Parlour, Bakery, Truck Wash, Saleyards, Butcher, Hotel, Pie shop, Day Care Centre, Schools, Panel Beating, Service Station, Bus Depot, Hospital, Flour Mill, Dairies, Tea/Coffee Manufacture and Plant Nurseries with open areas.
